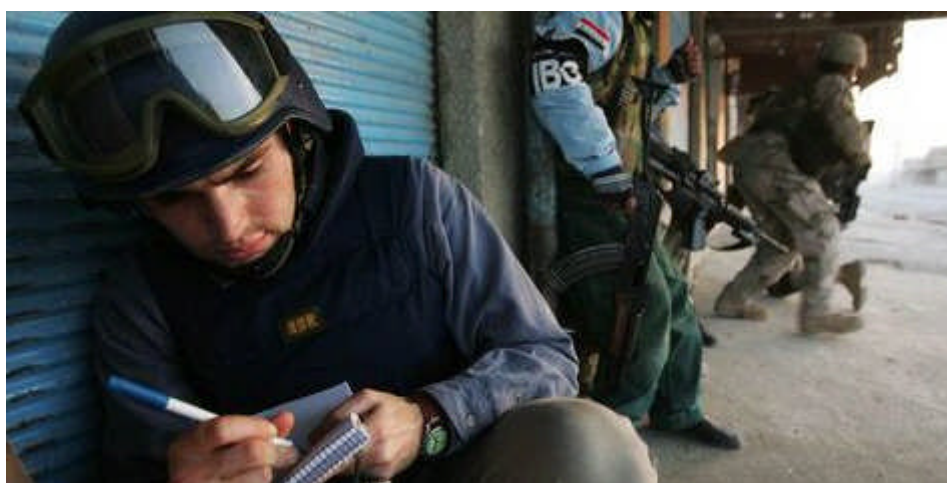

## Case study: **Behind the news...**
